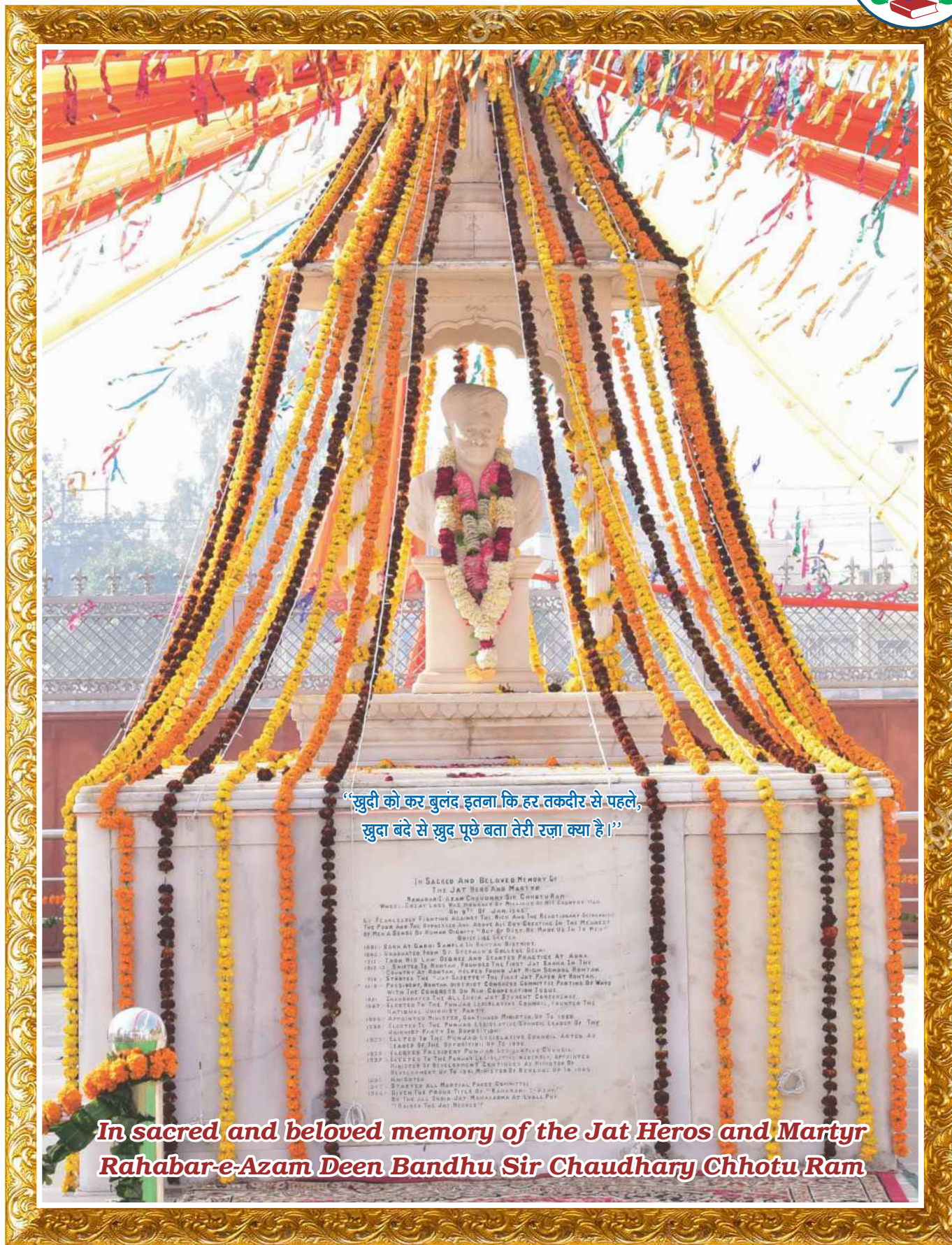

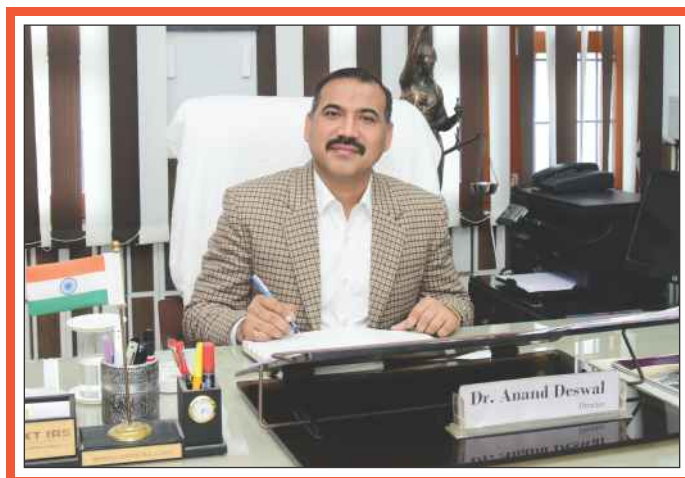

The main aim of the school was to impart the primary education in Rohtak. This small step taken by those people grew up into a big society named Jat Education Society. It was formed in 1914 under the name of Jat Anglo Sanskrit High School, Rohtak with the prime objective to serve the cause of education. In the year 1927, it changed its name as Jat Heroes Memorial Anglo Sanskrit High School, Rohtak. The society is presently running nine prestigious institutions.

Today, Jat Education Society (Regd.)Rohtak is a well-known name in India and abroad for its outstanding achievements great contribution in field of education. Our great men and forefathers started the work of spreading the light of education by laying the foundation of Jat School in the year 1912, today it has become a huge beacon in the form of Jat Educational Institutions, where at present more than 15 thousand students are taking education. For LL.B. (Hons.) 3 years course is 45% marks (42.75% marks in case of SC/ST candidates) in Bachelor degree or post-graduation in any discipline recognized by M.D. University, Rohtak).

LL.M. 2 Years Course
For Law Graduate Students
Approved seats : 30

For LL.M. 2 years course (Morning) LL.B. (Professional) with at least 50% marks (47.50% marks in case of SC/ST candidates) in aggregate or any other examination recognised by M.D. University, Rohtak as equivalent thereto.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ❖ For LLB 3 Years & LLM 2 Years Course applicant have to apply through online mode (Registration and filling form) on the M.D.U. Rohtak Website :
www.mdurohtak.ac.in or <http://admission.mdu.ac.in>
- ❖ For BALLB 5 Years Integrated Course applicant may get direct the Hard Copy of Prospectus along with Application form from the office of the Institute in working hours and may submit the same in prescribe time in the office of the Institute upto 3:00 pm on all working days.
- ❖ The admission form complete in all respects should be submitted in the office of the Institute. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected.
- ❖ Five passport size latest photographs at the back are to be attached.
- ❖ All the particulars and certificates submitted must be eligible and 3 attested copies of all the document be enclosed along with form.

COURSES, FEE STRUCTURE & ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ❖ A candidate who is admitted on the basis of false/incorrect/suppressed information submitted by him or by his guardian and at any subsequent time, if it is discovered that any portion thereof is incorrect or false or suppressed, his admission to the course shall stand cancelled automatically, ipso facto. Fees and other dues paid by him shall be forfeited. The institute may also take any suitable action against the said student and his guardian.
- ❖ Medium of instruction shall be English.
- ❖ LL.B. Course shall not be combined with any other course of study or apprenticeship except a Foreign language Course.
- ❖ Institute shall not register / enroll any student in violation of the merit list.
- ❖ The maximum period to complete a course is duration of the course + 3 year unless otherwise specified in any other ordinance of the affiliating university or the bar council of India, New Delhi.
- ❖ A candidate, who after seeking admission in a course left that course in between and seeks admission in other course may be allowed to continue that said course if he/she is able to complete the said course within the maximum period prescribed for completing a course which is the duration of the course + 3 years, unless otherwise specified in any other ordinance.
- ❖ A candidate who has qualified the qualifying examination and has a gap of more than two years or more, he/she can be granted admission to course if such a candidate submits an undertaking that during gap period he/she has not indulged in any illegal activities.
- ❖ Unless otherwise specified, there is no upper or lower age limit for admission in any course.

FEE STRUCTURE

Total fee of Rs. 40,000/- per annum for B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Years Integrated Course.

Total fee of Rs. 50,000/- per annum for LL.B. (Hons.) 3 Years Course.

Total fee of Rs. 65,000/- per annum for LL.M. 2 Years Course (Morning)

Note: Fee structure is subject to revision.

Fee once deposited shall not be refunded.

The above fee structure does not include hostel charges.



TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The teaching is conducted by pooling together numerous modes and methods of teaching to the students. The legal mind is required to be trained & cultivated by employing multi-farious innovative processes. Hence, the Law College has adopted an all-encompassing, holistic & practical pedagogical methodology envisaging the following features:

1. Participative and interactive class room teaching and guided library session.
2. Seminars, Extension Lectures and Assignments writing.
3. Regular & frequent debate, declamation competitions and quiz events etc.
4. Great emphasis on moot court and regular court visits.
5. Clinical Legal work, Legal Literacy & Legal Aid camps etc.
6. Educational Tours to witness the proceedings of High Court & Supreme Court.
7. Active participation in Lok Adalats at Sub-Division Level & District Level.
8. Practical training at the offices of Officer of Legal Profession during evening hours.
9. Availability of faculty to clear the doubts even in odd hours.
10. Special attention on Information & Technology subject.
11. Free access to internet services to students during college hours.
12. Jail & Police Station visits for students for knowing the Administrative of Justice more deeply.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Identity cards are to be always carried and Uniform is compulsory.
2. No visitor is allowed to meet student during college hours.
3. Students must remain in the college up to the college time.
4. If somebody comes to drop the students, he/she is supposed to park the vehicle a little away from the main gate, to allow smooth flow of traffic.

6. Avoid carrying heavy cash, jewellery or any other

abstain from the practice of lending and borrowing of money. The authorities do not take responsibility for any loss.

7. Students should make most of their time in academic/co-curricular pursuits.
8. The following activities will be viewed very seriously.
 - Littering the campus.
 - Scribbling on the walls and college property.
 - Making noise in the corridors.
 - Tampering with the vehicles of the staff members.
 - Students found in the canteen and roaming around while their class is going on.
9. The college authorities do not take any responsibility of the students conduct outside the college.
10. The instruction & directions as issued by the director from time to time will be adhered to by the students strictly, failing which students may face penalty or punishment.
11. No book will be issued without the library card and Mobile Phone is prohibited in College Campus.
12. As per the Hon'ble Supreme court ruling on Writ Petition Civil No. 656 of 1998, ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. It is a punishable offence and may such incident will invite action as per rules.
